TUITION FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

- 2. Payment will be allocated over a 12-month period without interest
- 3. The accounts of children of Lebanese Armed Services members will be settled in August of every year after the government covers the percentage allocated per student or child of an officer/member.

GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the graduate degree program must submit the following documents:

- 1. A graduate application form (pages 4 to 6) that can be filled out.
- 2. One recent passport-size photo.
- 3. A photocopy of the applicant's identity card, passport, or Armed Services ID.
- 4. Certified copies of all educational and professional certificates, diplomas and degrees earned.
- 5. Official transcript(s) of grades from all colleges or universities attended. Transcripts should be sent directly to the Admissions Office in a sealed envelope. Failure to declare enrollment at other institutions could result in the invalidation of admission and any credits or degrees earned.
- **6.** Equivalency of the bachelor's degree from the Ministry of Higher Education in Lebanon (depending on the university/college attended). Military degree is accepted.
- 7. Two academic and/or professional recommendation letters.
- 8. Certificate(s) of employment with a CV, in case of relevant work experience.
- 9. A non-refundable fee of 85\$ (L.L.129,000).

N.B.

Applicants to the School of Engineering should provide official scores of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE).

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

English is the official language of instruction at LAU, and applicants may be required to demonstrate their proficiency in the language by taking one of the below:

- 1. The English Entrance Exam (EEE) administered at LAU with a minimum score of 550.
- Internet-based TOEFL (IBT), with a minimum score of 90. The code for LAU is 2595.
 The institutional TOEFL is not accepted.
- 3. Academic IELTS with a minimum score of 7.

N.B.

- 1. Applicants to the School of Arts & Sciences, School of Engineering, and School of Architecture & Design who scored between 500 and 549 on the EEE, or between 80 and 89 on the Internet-based TOEFL (IBT), or 6.5 on the IELTS, have to register for the three-credit course ENG009 Remedial English, or retake and pass the English test within the first year of enrollment.
 - Applicants with EEE, IBT and IELTS scores below 500, 80 and 6.5 respectively will be requested to register and attend the CEP English Prep course before taking the EEE again.
 - The 50 percent LAU Contribution applies to Remedial English and CEP English Prep courses.
- 2. English proficiency exams may not be required from applicants from universities recognized by LAU in which the language of instruction is English.
